# MINUTES HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

## March 13, 2014

## I. CALL TO ORDER

The monthly meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission was called to order on Thursday, March 13, 2014 at 6:30 p.m. by Commissioner Simon Batistich in the absence of the Chairman.

### II. ROLL CALL

Commissioners Batistich, Cummins, Roy, Schwartz and Yates present. Commissioners Buschman and Flynn absent. Martha Glas, Village Planner, and Trustees Ron Stapleton and Jeanette Virgilio, Grant Review Committee, were also present.

### III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by Mr. Cummins, seconded by Ms. Roy, to approve the minutes of the February 13, 2013 meeting. Voice vote: 5 ayes. Motion passed.

## IV. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

No report.

## V. PUBLIC HEARING - None scheduled.

### VI. APPLICATIONS

## A. 03.14 – Certificate of Appropriateness

## Exterior Remodel – 212 Stephen Street

Aldo Bottalla, owner of 212 Stephen described the scope of the project including removal of existing wood siding and wood trim, installation of Tyvec house wrap, replacement of all rotted wood, installation of 6" James Hardy siding, replacement of architectural trim, and replacement of 12 vinyl replacement double hung windows on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor with Climate Guard windows in white. He displayed a color palette of siding in neutral gray/taupe shades and the commission approved his choices. Mr. Batistich emphasized retaining the existing decorative elements of the building at the roof line and on the first floor.

After the presentation, a motion was made by Ms. Roy, seconded by Mr. Cummins, to approve a Certificate of Appropriateness for the exterior remodel, per the application and materials submitted and dated 2/24/14. Voice vote: 5 ayes. Motion passed.

## B. 4.14 – Certificate of Appropriateness

# Sign – 431 Talcott Street, Pollyanna Brewing Co.

The application submitted by Paul Ciciora requests installation of a brushed stainless steel sign, 14' long by 20" high to be installed in the designated sign area of the building. Comments by the Commission complimented the design and materials selected for the sign as very appropriate for both the building and the business. Motion by Mr. Schwartz, seconded by Mr. Cummins, to approve a Certificate of Appropriateness for the installation of the sign, per the application and materials submitted and dated 3/5/2014. Voice vote: 5 ayes. Motion passed.

## VII. NEW BUSINESS

Martha Glas, Village Planner, informed the Commission that approximately \$30,000 is still available for grant projects in this fiscal year. Two members of the Commission have been designated as voting members of the Grant Review Committee: Simon Batistich and Tom Flynn. In the absence of Mr. Flynn, Mr. Cummins nominated Mr. Schwartz to serve as the

proxy voting member for purposes of this review. The Commission reviewed Façade Grant Applications for the following projects:

## A. 431 Talcott Street - Sign

The work sheet submitted for this grant application reflects a total project cost of \$3,200 for fabrication and installation of the brushed stainless steel sign reviewed by the Commission on this agenda. The project would be eligible for \$1,600 in grant funding. Ms. Glas explained that one half of the cost of the sign was included in an incentive package offered by the Village for location of this business in Lemont, with the funds for the incentive to come from the grant program budget. Mr. Batistich commented that assisting this business is a positive for the community and the downtown in particular and recommended that the funds in the amount of \$1,600 be approved. The Commission agreed.

B. 117 Stephen Street – Replacement of 3 sets of double doors and transoms, front façade. The grant application reflects a total project cost of \$17,937.77 with maximum amount of grant funding at \$8.968.89. The Commission approved a Certificate for this project at its February meeting. Ms. Glas informed the Commission that a previous grant was approved for this address for awnings approximately 11 years ago. After verifying that sufficient funds in the budget would be available, the Commission recommended funding the grant at the full amount requested.

# C. 212 Stephen Street – Re-siding and Replacement of Windows.

The grant application reflects a total project cost of \$29,300 with maximum amount of grant funding at \$14,600. The Commission commented that this is a very worthy project in a gateway area and a building that has been blighted by neglect. Again, verifying that sufficient funds are available in the grant budget, the Commission recommended funding the grant at the full amount for this project.

Commissioners Batistich and Schwartz voted to approve grant funding as specified above. Trustees Stapleton and Virgilio concurred.
