## **BACKGROUND/HISTORY**

The Village of Lemont established the Gateway TIF District on January 19, 2009 in the hopes to spur development in the area near Route 83 and Main Street. At the time of adoption, there were several parcels in the vicinity that were not included in the TIF because they were not annexed into the Village. For the last several months, the Village has been going through the process of amending its Gateway TIF District. The primary reason for the amendment is to include the parcels of property in the TIF that were not already in the Gateway TIF District. The properties to be added are depicted in the shaded expansion area on the map included in the attached ordinances.

As adding property to a TIF District is considered a major amendment, the entire TIF adoption process was required and followed leading up to this point of adoption. Please see timeline below of key dates:

Included in the TIF Amendment and attached to this memo are three separate ordinances that must be acted upon.

- 1. Ordinance Approving Redevelopment Plan & Project
- 2. Ordinance Designating Redevelopment Plan & Project
- 3. Ordinance Adopting TIF

There is one minor item of note. There are two pieces of property that were included in the TIF plan, but will not be part of the TIF District because they will not be annexed at time of TIF adoption. These pieces of property were discussed at the July 15<sup>th</sup> Committee of the Whole. Following the advice of TIF council, it is our recommendation to approve the TIF as presented, then amend the TIF at the first meeting in August to remove these other parcels. The Village's TIF and engineering consultants are working on the legal descriptions and updated map for the TIF that will be presented at the August 12<sup>th</sup> Village Board Meeting.

The Municipality by its President and Board of Trustees hereby certifies, finds and determines that (i) less than 10 displacements with respect to inhabited residential units are to occur (ii) there are fewer than 75 inhabited residential units within the Redevelopment Project Area.

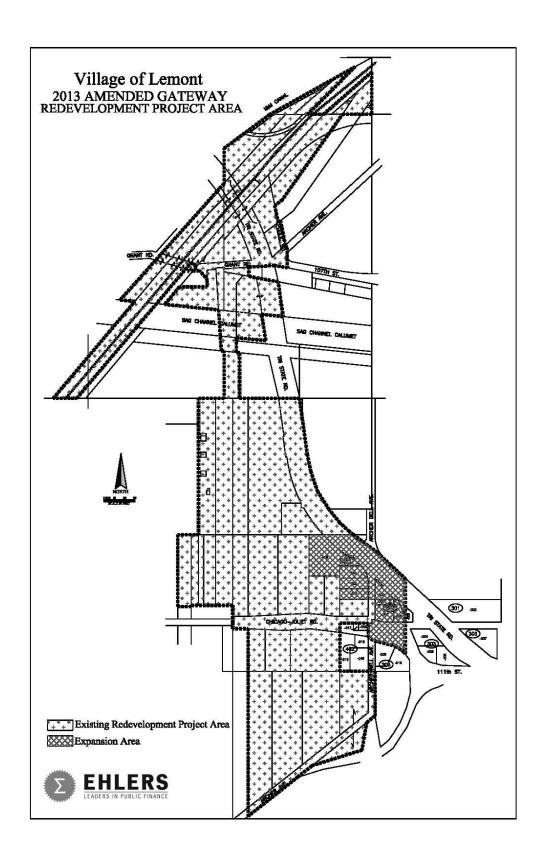

It includes parcels that front on the west side of IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road between Archer Bell Avenue on the north and Chicago-Joliet Road on the south, including parcel 22-14-401-026, but excluding parcel 22-13-13-302-006. It also includes parcels that front on both sides of Archer Bell Avenue between IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road on the north and Chicago-Joliet Road on the south, excluding parcels 22-14-402-008 and 22-14-402-017. The Expansion Area includes all adjoining rights-of-way within the Village of Lemont.

## **General Description of Area as a Whole** (as previously amended by O-12-09 and O-02-10):

A general description of the Gateway Redevelopment Project Area, as amended, is those properties along IL Rt. 83/Tri-State Road from south of the I&M Canal to about the intersection of Archer Avenue and Archer Bell Avenue. The area includes the properties on the east side of IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road within approximately 1600 feet of said right-of-way, between the I&M Canal on the north and Archer Avenue on the south, excluding parcels 22-11-500-003, 22-11-500-004, 22-14-201-044, 22-14-201-009, 22-14-501-005, and 22-14-201-021. A rail line crosses IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road between the I&M Canal and the Sag Channel Calumet. The area includes the railroad parcel on the west side of IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road and the parcel just to the north of it. ## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING TAX INCREMENT FINANCING FOR THE VILLAGE OF LEMONT, ILLINOIS 2013 AMENDED GATEWAY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA

WHEREAS, the Village of Lemont, Illinois (the "Municipality"), acting through its President and Board of Trustees (the "Corporate Authorities") and other officers and representatives, has duly noticed, held and conducted all proceedings, including the required public meeting, public hearing and joint review board actions, preliminary to the designation of the 2013 Amended Gateway Redevelopment Project Area (the original area, as amended in 2013, collectively, the "Redevelopment Project Area," as described in the attached Exhibit A), the approval of the "Tax Increment Finance, Village of Lemont, 2013 Amended Gateway Redevelopment Project Area, Amended Redevelopment Plan and Project" (as amended in 2013, collectively, the "Redevelopment Plan" and "Redevelopment Project") and the adoption of tax increment financing to finance the Redevelopment Plan and the Redevelopment Project, all under and pursuant to the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act (65 ILCS 5/11-74.4-1 et seq., as supplemented and amended (the "TIF Act")).

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LEMONT, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**Section 1**. **Findings**. The Municipality, by its Corporate Authorities, hereby finds, as follows:

- (1) The Redevelopment Project Area on the whole has not been subject to growth and development through investment by private enterprise and would not reasonably be anticipated to be developed without the adoption of the Redevelopment Plan.
- (2) The Redevelopment Plan and the related Redevelopment Project conform to the comprehensive plan for the development of the Municipality as a whole.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Adopt Tax Increment Financing</u>. Under the TIF Act, the Municipality hereby adopts, approves and authorizes the application of tax increment financing with respect to the Redevelopment Plan, Redevelopment Project and Redevelopment Project Area.

Section 3. Term. The Redevelopment Project Area, and the estimated dates of completion of the Redevelopment Project and the retirement of obligations issued to finance redevelopment project costs shall be not more than 23 years from the initial base date of the date of adoption of the initial ordinance adopting tax increment finance for the Redevelopment Project Area (but shall be 24 years in connection with the Municipality's right under the TIF to

receive the 23<sup>rd</sup> year of incremental property taxes by December 31 in the 24<sup>th</sup> year, i.e. **December 31, 20**\_\_\_) from the adoption of the initial ordinance approving the initial Redevelopment Project Area.

Section 4. Incremental Taxes. The Municipality hereby adopts tax increment financing and directs that the ad valorem taxes, if any, arising from the levies upon taxable real property in the Redevelopment Project Area by taxing districts and tax rates determined in the manner provided in paragraph (c) of Section 11-74.4-9 of the TIF Act each year after the effective date of this ordinance until redevelopment project costs and all municipal obligations financing redevelopment project costs incurred under the TIF Act have been paid shall be divided as follows:

- (a) That portion of taxes levied upon each taxable lot, block, tract or parcel of real property which is attributable to the lower of the current equalized assessed value or the initial equalized assessed value of each such taxable lot, block, tract or parcel of real property in the Redevelopment Project Area shall be allocated to and when collected shall be paid by the county collector to the respective affected taxing districts in the manner required by law in the absence of the adoption of tax increment allocation financing.
- (b) That portion, if any, of such taxes which is attributable to the increase in the current equalized assessed valuation of each taxable lot, block, tract or parcel of real property in the Redevelopment Project Area over and above the initial equalized assessed value of each property in the Redevelopment Project Area shall be allocated to and when collected shall be paid to the Municipality's treasurer who shall deposit such taxes into a special fund called the "Special Tax Allocation Fund" of the Municipality for the purpose of paying redevelopment project costs and obligations incurred in the payment thereof.

<u>Section 5</u>. <u>Filing</u>. The Village Clerk shall file a certified copy of this ordinance with the County Clerk of Cook County, Illinois, and under the TIF Act shall obtain a certificate from such County Clerk as to the total initial equalized assessed value "EAV" of all taxable property in the Redevelopment Project Area. In providing this certification, the County Clerk shall use the tax year <u>2012</u> in determining such total initial EAV.

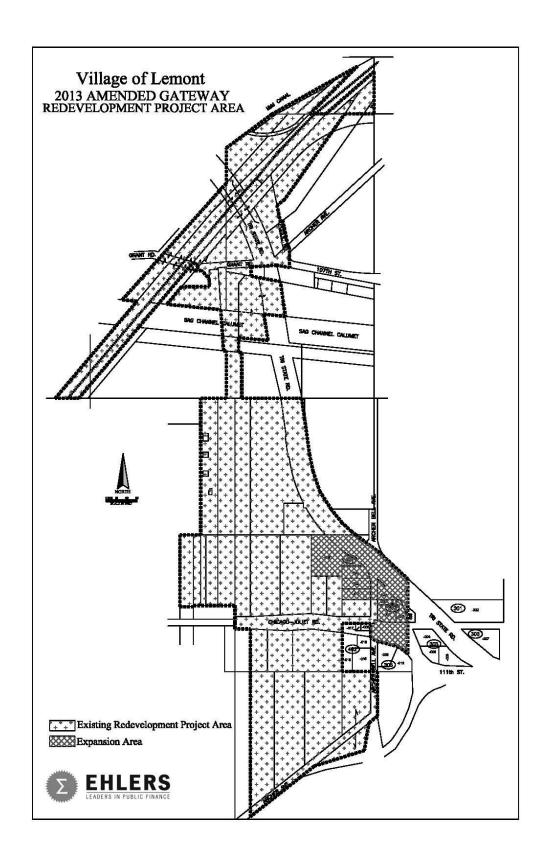

#### **General Description of New Area / Expansion Area Only:**

A general description of the Expansion Area is those properties on the west side of IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road in the vicinity of Archer Bell Avenue and Chicago- Joliet Road. It includes parcels that front on the west side of IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road between Archer Bell Avenue on the north and Chicago-Joliet Road on the south, including parcel 22-14-401-026, but excluding parcel 22-13-13-302-006. It also includes parcels that front on both sides of Archer Bell Avenue between IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road on the north and Chicago-Joliet Road on the south, excluding parcels 22-14-402-008 and 22-14-402-017. The Expansion Area includes all adjoining rights-of-way within the Village of Lemont.

General Description of Area as a Whole (as previously amended by O-12-09 and O-02-10):

A general description of the Gateway Redevelopment Project Area, as amended, is those properties along IL Rt. 83/Tri-State Road from south of the I&M Canal to about the intersection of Archer Avenue and Archer Bell Avenue. The area includes the properties on the east side of IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road within approximately 1600 feet of said right-of-way, between the I&M Canal on the north and Archer Avenue on the south, excluding parcels 22-11-500-003, 22-11-500-004, 22-14-201-044, 22-14-201-009, 22-14-501-005, and 22-14-201-021. A rail line crosses IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road between the I&M Canal and the Sag Channel Calumet. The area includes the railroad parcel on the west side of IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road and the parcel just to the north of it. The area also includes the parcels on the west side IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road, north of Grant Road, and east of the rail line. The area includes those parcels south of Grant Road, west of IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road, and north of the Sag Channel Calumet, except parcels 22-14-200-006 and 22-14-200-012. Parcels 22-14-200-010 and 22-14-201-018 are on both sides of the Sag Channel Calumet and are included in the area. South of the Sag Channel Calumet, the area includes those parcels west of IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road and north of Chicago-Joliet Road, within approximately 2,000 feet of IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road, excluding those parcels that are unincorporated. The area includes parcels that front on the west side of IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road between Archer Bell Avenue on the north and Chicago-Joliet Road on the south, including parcel 22-14-401-026, but excluding parcel 22-13-13-302006. It also includes parcels that front on both sides of Archer Bell Avenue between IL Rt. 83/Tri State Road on the north and Chicago-Joliet Road on the south. The area also includes the parcels south of Chicago-Joliet Road, west of Archer Bell Road, and north of the Archer Avenue right-of-way, within approximately 1,150 feet of the right of way of Archer Bell Avenue, but excluding parcels 22-14-402-008, 22-14-402-015, 22-14-402-016, 22-14-,402-017, 22-14-402-018. The area also includes all adjoining rights-of-way within the Village of Lemont.
