This discussion would continue at future Committee meetings to give staff better direction on updates to the updates to the Comprehensive Plan.

In particular getting property owners to take care of their properties such as the parking lots in strip centers and other miscellaneous issues. Staff would be presenting options at future committee meetings on this topic.

There is interest from an Italian pizza place but they inquired about a drive through in the alley. It is going to be difficult to accomplish because of stacking on Main Street, but this idea would be explored further at a future meeting.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LEMONT, ILLINOIS DELETING CERTAIN PROPERTIES FROM THE 2013 AMENDED GATEWAY TAX INCREMENT FINANCE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees (the "Corporate Authorities") of the Village of Lemont, Illinois (the "Municipality") (i) on January 19, 2009 adopted a series of Ordinances: No. O-05-09, No. O-06-09, and No. O-07-09, as supplemented and amended by Ordinance No. O-12-09, adopted January 26, 2009 and (ii) on July 22, 2013 adopted as series of amending Ordinances: No. O-29-13, No. O-30-13 and No. O-31-13 (all of (i) and (ii), collectively, the "TIF Ordinances"), adopting tax increment finance ("TIF"), approving the original and amended redevelopment plan (collectively, the "Plan") and the related original and amended redevelopment project (collectively, the "Project") for the original and amended redevelopment project area (generally known as the "2013 Amended Gateway Redevelopment Project Area", collectively, the "Area"); and

WHEREAS, the Municipality desires to delete certain parcels (as described in the exhibit hereto, the "**Deleted Parcels**", shown with the dark-lined borders in the attached diagram) of real estate from the Area; and

WHEREAS, the amendments under this ordinance effect changes which do not (1) add additional parcels of property to the proposed redevelopment project area, (2) substantially affect the general land uses proposed in the redevelopment plan, (3) substantially change the nature of the redevelopment project, (4) increase the total estimated redevelopment project cost set out in the redevelopment plan by more than 5% after adjustment for inflation from the date the plan was adopted, (5) add additional redevelopment project costs to the itemized list of redevelopment project costs set out in the redevelopment plan, or (6) increase the number of inhabited residential units to be displaced from the redevelopment project area, as measured from the time of creation of the redevelopment project area to a total of more than 10.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LEMONT, ILLINOIS, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Amendment</u>. The Deleted Parcels shall be and hereby are deleted from the Area and in connection with the Plan and the Project. The Area, the Plan and the Project shall be and are hereby amended by such deletion of the Deleted Parcels. A copy of this ordinance shall be attached to the Plan to effect the amendments hereby, but any failure to so attach this ordinance shall not abrogate, diminish, impair or delay the effect of such amendments.

Section 2. Publication. Within 10 days of the adoption and approval of this ordinance, this ordinance shall be published in the *Lemont Reporter/Met*, published and of general circulation within the Municipality, and a copy shall be duly mailed by certified mail (i) to each registrant on the interested parties registry with respect to the Area and (ii) to each taxing district with property constituting a part of the Area, which amendments are authorized under Section 11-74.4-5 of the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act (65 ILCS 5/11-74.4-1 *et seq.*).

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Filing</u>. The Village Clerk shall file a certified copy of this ordinance, together with a list of the PIN's for the Deleted Parcels, with the County Clerk of Cook County, Illinois in which all of the Area is located.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Effective</u>. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication in the manner required by applicable law.



BACKGROUND/HISTORY

As part of the FY 14 budget process, funds were budgeted to improve 1st Street. The overall project will be discussed in further detail at the August 19th Village Board Committee of the Whole.

The utility relocation portion of the project is a time sensitive item, consequently staff is presenting this item to the Board at this time so the project can proceed on schedule. The Village has received an estimate for the costs associated with relocating the utility poles in conjunction with the 1st Street project. In order to schedule the work for the end of August so the project can stay on track, the Village needs to enter into the agreement and submit a partial payment by August 13th. Total cost for the work is estimated to be \$135,600, of which a \$55,000 partial payment is required to schedule the work. The attached resolution authorizes the Village Administrator to enter into the agreement, submit the partial payment, and submit the remainder of the payment when appropriate.

This letter is in reply to an inquiry regarding the Village of Lemont's (the Village) request to relocate ComEd's (the Company) overhead electric lines along First Street. More specifically, the subject electric lines are currently situated along the west side of First Street from McCarthy Road to Schultz Street.

The engineered estimate of the cost to relocate the existing overhead facilities is approximately \$135,600. The cost represents an engineered design cost estimate only and is not a final cost for ComEd to provide any work to relocate the subject facilities. The final construction costs may differ depending on the mutual agreement of facilities relocated, final construction, difficulty of work area and what the accepted contract bid is for performing some or all of the work. The Village should take note that final costs will be based off the total actual charges that ComEd incurs to complete this project.

General Assumptions:

- This cost estimate is good for 90 days from the date on this letter.
- This estimate is for the relocation of ComEd electric facilities only. The Village will need to contact other utilities for their relocation cost, if applicable.
- This estimate is based upon current tariffs with no escalation.
- Construction estimate and schedule is based on normal 40-hour workweek, without overtime, weekend, or Holiday work.
- ComEd will bear the cost of the removal and installation of three poles, and two directional bores including
 polypipe and secondary cable per the franchise agreement.

Others Responsibilities:

- Village is responsible to obtain all permits and easements at customer's expense as necessary to support ComEd's construction schedule and installation methods, including but not limited to trimming without restriction.
- No landscaping or beautification will be provided by ComEd, only rough grade back fill of all areas
 disturbed by the ComEd construction removal and installation of equipment. All restoration, finished
 grading, sodding and/or seeding is to be completed by the Village within both the right-of-way and private
 property areas.

Scope of Work:

- Set 7 wood poles w/cross arm construction, remove 8 poles and associated primary/secondary wire and equipment.
- Perform three directional bores and install approximately 140' of 4" poly pipe/conduit and 650' of secondary underground cable.
- Transfer existing wire and install 400' of additional overhead primary wire, and other associated overhead equipment.



If the Village wishes to proceed with this project, please sign this letter below and return back to me with a partial payment for the work totaling \$55,000. Based on our earlier communications, I am anticipating starting this work late August. Please provide this payment by 8/13/13 for the work to start in August.
