The bid was \$37,686.50 (25.44%) above the Engineer's Estimate of \$148,127.00, apparently due to the expected multiple mobilization expected by the contractor, caused by the utility relocation work.

As part of the capital improvements designated in the FY 14 budget, the Village budged funds for repairs to the following bridges: Stephen Street over I&M Canal, Old Lemont over DesPlaines River, Ed Bossert Drive over I&M Canal and Derby Road over Pine Needles Drive. The engineers estimate (Crawford, Murphy & Tully) prior to bid was approximately \$241,000. The low bidder presented a cost of \$460,166 to complete the work. After discussing at the Committee of the Whole, staff is recommending the rejection of the bids at this time. Staff will be working with the consulting engineer to rebid the project.
