## **RULES FOR STREET SOLICITATION**

- 1. You must be 18 years of age or older.
- 2. You must carry a Government issued photo ID card which verifies your age, such as a driver's license or state ID card.
- 3. You must wear a badge or sticker, which prominently displays the name of the organization for which the solicitation is being conducted.
- 4. You must wear bright orange or yellow safety vests.
- Withdraw from an intersection to a place of safety on a median or on the side of a highway before the light turns green in the direction they are working.
- 6. Limit solicitation activity to one person for each lane of traffic.
- 7. Refrain from yelling at or otherwise distracting motorists and from touching any vehicle.
- 8. Do not conduct any solicitation activity before sunrise or after sunset or in inclement weather during which, in the judgment of any law enforcement officer, conducting solicitation activity would constitute a hazard to individuals conducting solicitation activity or to motorists.
- 9. Organizations standing in the roadway shall furnish this office with proof of a liability insurance policy in the amount of not less than \$1,000,000.
- 10. Any organization not abiding by these rules set in place may be asked to vacate the premises by any law enforcement officer and have their solicitation permission revoked for a period determined by the Chief of Police.
