RULES FOR STREET SOLICITATION

1. You must be 18 years of age or older.
2. You must carry a Government issued photo ID card which verifies your age, such as a driver's license or state ID card.
3. You must wear a badge or sticker, which prominently displays the name of the organization for which the solicitation is being conducted.
4. You must wear bright orange or yellow safety vests.
5. Withdraw from an intersection to a place of safety on a median or on the side of a highway before the light turns green in the direction they are working.
6. Limit solicitation activity to one person for each lane of traffic.
7. Refrain from yelling at or otherwise distracting motorists and from touching any vehicle.
8. Do not conduct any solicitation activity before sunrise or after sunset or in inclement weather during which, in the judgment of any law enforcement officer, conducting solicitation activity would constitute a hazard to individuals conducting solicitation activity or to motorists.
9. Organizations standing in the roadway shall furnish this office with proof of a liability insurance policy in the amount of not less than \$1,000,000.
10. Any organization not abiding by these rules set in place may be asked to vacate the premises by any law enforcement officer and have their solicitation permission revoked for a period determined by the Chief of Police.
