

Mayor's Charity Fund Application

There are many great organizations in our community making a difference. Please read the eligibility requirements thoroughly to determine whether your organization will qualify to receive funds. These requirements align with the intent of the funds being distributed.

The Mayor's Drive for Charity is an annual golf outing for the sole purpose of raising funds in support of Lemont non-profit organizations who help those in need in our community through funding activities, providing essential services to youth groups, seniors, special needs, and educational programs.

Eligibility for non-profit organizations:

1. Must center on philanthropic goals and demonstrate that the project and purpose of the funds will be used to benefit those that the non-profit organization supports.
2. The organization receiving the funds must be located in the Village of Lemont or Lemont Township and primarily serve residents that reside in the Village of Lemont or Lemont Township.
3. Funding to sport teams or leagues will only be considered if funds are used solely for families requiring financial assistance to off-set registration fees in order to participate in the program (proof will be requested).
4. The organization should be registered with the IRS as a non-profit under Section 501(c) of IRS Code.

The Mayor's Charity Fund will not support:

1. Organizations that will provide funds received from the Mayor's Charity Fund to another organization that has also applied and will receive funds from the Mayor's Charity Fund (organization to organization).
2. Village of Lemont organized events, projects, commissions, or committees.
3. Private foundations.
4. Individual pursuits.
5. Private or public elementary, secondary or high schools.
6. Taxing bodies (fire department, library, park district, school districts, Township, Village of Lemont).
7. Political or fraternal organizations, service clubs, or third-party organizations that raise funds for charity.
8. The publication of books or movie productions.
9. Endowment or capital campaigns.
10. Conferences, seminars, events or golf tournaments.
11. Travel for individuals or groups.
12. Funding for organizations general/operational accounts.
