A RESOLUTION APPROVING A SECOND AMENDMENT TO REFUSE, RECYCLING, AND LANDSCAPE WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Village of Lemont, Counties of Cook, Will and DuPage, Illinois, ("the Village") is a municipality in the State of Illinois with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village and Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. entered into a Refuse, Recycling and Landscape Waste Collection and Disposal Agreement on or about April 14, 2014 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement is set to expire on April 30, 2022 and the parties desire to extend the term for an additional three years until April 30, 2025

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees find that it is in the best interests of the Village to authorize the Second Amendment to Refuse, Recycling, and Landscaping Waste Collection and Disposal Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A ("Amendment");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lemont, Counties of Cook, Will and DuPage, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: RECITALS.

That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof as if fully set forth in their entirety.

SECTION 2:

The Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lemont hereby approve the Second Amendment to Refuse, Recycling, and Landscaping Waste Collection and Disposal Agreement with the Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. in substantially the same form as attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, subject to attorney review.

SECTION 3:

The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized, respectively, to execute the Amendment.

SECTION 4:

This Resolution, and its parts, are declared to be severable and any section, subsection, sentence, clause, provision, or portion of this Resolution that is declared invalid such decision shall not affect the validity of any other portion of this Resolution, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5:

All Resolutions and Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6:

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

EXHIBIT A

SECOND AMENDMENT TO REFUSE, RECYCLING, AND LANDSCAPE WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL AGREEMENT

This Amendment to the Refuse, Recycling and Landscape Waste Collection and Disposal Agreement (the "Amendment") is entered into on December _____, 2021 by and between Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. ("Contractor") and Village of Lemont ("Village").

Recitals

- A. Village and Contractor entered into a Refuse, Recycling and Landscape Waste Collection and Disposal Agreement on or about April 14, 2014 (the "Agreement"); and
- B. The Agreement is set to expire on April 30, 2022 and the parties desire to extend the term for an additional three years until April 30, 2025.

Agreement

The parties agree to amend the Agreement in the following manner:

- 1) Section 4, Contract Period shall be amended to extend the term until April 30, 2025.
- 2) Section IV.C. The Contractor's monthly unit rate for all services including At Your Door Special Collection program shall be increased by 3% per year on the anniversary of the first day of the Contract period.
- 3) Section 12. Add the following sentence at the end of this section, "For the avoidance of doubt, Contractor shall comply with prevailing wage requirements and labor regulations enforced by state or federal agencies applicable to the Services provided by Contractor.
- 4) Except as modified herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.
