#6060 - Tech Review: No new items were submitted.

#6061 - Tier Two and Form R Reports: B. Reinke reports as they become available.

**#6076** - Midwest Generation: The parent Co. of Midwest has declared bankruptcy, but Romeoville Station remains operational. Renewed OAN membership.
