 - Citgo grant has not been solidified. Turnover at Citgo caused lack of criteria for grant applicants.
 - Clear brush along canal heading East and continue picnic grove area has been set for direction from the commission.

 - a. Brush along edges cleaned up desired
 - b. New Peterson's development any building specifications and drain pipe plans?
 - i. New downtown focus group (intent create vision of downtown Lemont)

 - c. Bubblers need to be cleaned twice a day due to shallow area and amount of debris in canal
 - d. Jeannette to send information to Jason Berry and Dave Maher on who cleaned trees out of the canal.
